

## AFP Foundation for Philanthropy – Canada National Scholarship Program

The National Scholarship Program aims to assist individuals employed in the fundraising and not-for-profit sectors in attending educational events in order to develop and improve their knowledge and skills. Scholarships up to a value of \$1000 will be awarded to successful applicants to cover registration, travel and/or tuition fees.

Examples of programs that can be funded through the National Scholarship Program include, but are not limited to: AFP CFRE Review Course, AFP Fundamentals of Fundraising, AFP International Conference, local AFP chapter workshops, and post-secondary tuition costs.

All candidates must be employed by a registered Canadian charity or non-profit organization, and cannot have received a national scholarship from the AFP Foundation for Philanthropy – Canada within the last three years (from date of acceptance).

Successful applicants must submit an expense report and impact report for the event/program attended. 50% of the granted funds will be issued upon the applicant's formal acceptance of the scholarship; the remainder will be issued upon receipt of an expense report and impact report.

Applications will be assessed twice annually. In 2017, application deadlines are March 15 and September 15.

The event/program for which funding is sought must conclude within one calendar year of the chosen application deadline. All applicants will be notified of the selection committee's decision three weeks after the deadline date.

The number and amount of scholarships granted is at the discretion of the selection committee and dependent on the funding available.
